#### FLOWERS

01. Gladiolus: three specimen in a vase.
02. Rose: one specimen in a vase.
03. Annuals: one vase of 5 of one kind.
04. Mixed flowers: one vase of not more than 5 stems.
05. Best cut flowers from your garden: one bloom, stem or spray.

#### VEGETABLES

- 06 Collection of vegetables: 3 kinds, not less than 3 of each kind. Parsley may be used for dressing. Max frontage 24 ins.
07. Beans, runner: Qty 4.
08. Beetroot: 3 (tops trimmed to approx. 4 ins.).
09. Onions, from sets: 3.
10. Marrow (table quality): 1.
11. Potatoes: 3.
12. Tomatoes, other than cherry type: 3.
13. Tomatoes, cherry type: 4.
14. Any other vegetable not mentioned above: 3.
15. Longest Runner Bean

#### POT PLANTS, MAXIMUM POT SIZE 8 INCHES

16. Cacti or succulent: one.
17. Fuchsia: one.
18. Begonia (tuberous) flowering: one

20. Flowering plant, not mentioned above: one
21. Foliage plant, excluding cacti, succulent, ferns & begonia:(1)

42. Carrots: 3 (tops trimmed to approx. 4 ins.).
43. Shallots (large): 6.
44. Shallots (pickling): 6
45. Cucumber: 1.
46. Beetroot: 3 (tops trimmed to approx. 4 ins).
